



## COVID Safe public health guidelines – updated 10 January 2022

When visiting our open gardens please keep in mind:

### **We require everyone over the age of 16 attending an open garden to be double vaccinated.**

This is to protect our OGV community of volunteers, garden owners and garden guests, and to ensure we can calculate the number of ticket holders permitted under the Government's Roadmap.

*Our volunteers will ask to see proof you've checked in on the Services Victoria QR code and proof of your vaccination. You can show proof of vaccination:*

- by linking your COVID-19 digital certificate to the Service Victoria app.
- by including a COVID-19 digital certificate on your smartphone wallet or
- by showing a paper-copy of your Immunisation History Statement, or an eligible proof of exemption.

### **Other Covid Guidelines in place:**

- All our garden openings adhere to current Victorian COVID Guidelines.
- Tickets for smaller gardens are available in hourly time slots via Trybooking. Please arrive at your chosen time, but you are free to enjoy the garden at your leisure. Tickets for larger gardens can be booked between 10 and 4.30pm on both the Saturday and Sunday of an opening. Tickets are also available at the entrance of each opening.
- QR codes will be in place and hand sanitiser provided.
- Carry a mask at all times. If the current COVID restrictions require a mask to be worn at the time of the opening, please wear it.
- Tickets are non-refundable unless the opening is cancelled.
