



COVID Safe public health guidelines – updated October 2021

We can't wait to open gardens again. When visiting our open gardens please keep in mind:

We require everyone over the age of 16 attending an open garden to be double vaccinated.

This is to protect our OGV community of volunteers, garden owners and garden guests, and to ensure we can calculate the number of ticket holders permitted under the Government's Roadmap.

Our volunteers will ask to see proof you've checked in on the Services Victoria QR code and proof of your vaccination. You can show proof of vaccination:

- by linking your COVID-19 digital certificate to the Service Victoria app.
- by including a COVID-19 digital certificate on your smartphone wallet or
- by showing a paper-copy of your Immunisation History Statement, or an eligible proof of exemption.

Other Covid Guidelines in place:

- All our garden openings adhere to current Victorian COVID Guidelines.
- You are free to enjoy the garden at your leisure anytime on Saturday or Sunday of an opening between 10 & 4.30pm.
- QR codes will be in place and hand sanitiser provided
- Carry a mask at all times. If the current COVID restrictions require a mask to be worn at the time of the opening, please wear it.
- Tickets are non-refundable unless the opening is cancelled.
