

## Kid's corner

### Have you ever made your own seed tape?

I just love collecting my own seeds. It means that you can regrow the same plant the following year.

This is a fun way to store your seeds for easy sowing in spring or the following year.

### What you will need

- Any type of seeds
- Tissues
- Water based glue
- Glue brush
- Scissors

### Method

1. Cut a tissue it into strips.
2. Place the lengths of tissue onto a surface that is shiny. (Using a shiny surface will help the tissues not to stick.)
3. Dot small amounts of glue along the surface of the tissue, leaving spaces in between.
4. Place your seeds carefully onto the glue. I have used large Holly Hock seeds as I can see them easily.
5. Leave your strips out to dry.
6. When dry, place the strips into a paper bag and label them with the name of your seeds.
